

DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2016-2017

The Houston Young Lawyers Association's Diversity Committee is awarding "diversity scholarships" to students at each of the Houston-area law schools.

THE HYLA Diversity Committee

The HYLA Diversity Committee was created in 2016. Its objectives are:

- to engage with lawyers of color, women lawyers, lawyers with disabilities and lawyers with nontraditional sexual orientations and gender identification;
- to promote increased participation by diverse lawyers in the activities, programs, and projects of the Houston Young Lawyers Association;
- to encourage all members of the Houston Young Lawyers Association and the greater Houston legal community to acknowledge the importance of diversity, to promote greater inclusion of diverse members of the profession, and to facilitate greater access to programs, services, and employment opportunities for diverse members of the profession.

The Diversity Scholarship Program is one of the many Diversity Committee sponsored activities/programs designed to meet the objectives each year. The Diversity Committee reviews all applications and select the scholarship recipients based on the criteria described below.

HYLA recognizes diversity based upon gender, national origin, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, socio-economic status and geography.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA, ELIGIBILITY AND ANNOUNCEMENT

The Diversity Committee intents to award scholarships in amounts ranging from \$500-\$2,000 to law students that attend any of the ABA-accredited law schools in Houston. The recipient must be attending one of the Houston-area, ABA-accredited law schools. In awarding the scholarships, the Diversity Committee will consider the applicant's response to the essay question, resume, demonstrated commitment to diversity, and other criteria such as academic performance.

Scholarship winners will be announced, and winners will be invited to attend the Houston Young Lawyers Foundation/HYLA Law Day Luncheon on Thursday, April 27, 2017 at the Marriott Marquis Houston.
